Dear Distributor/Customer

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that Stryker Singapore Pte Ltd, on behalf of Stryker Medical, is voluntarily recalling in Singapore the Stryker 2-Stage and 3-Stage I.V. Poles distributed on beds, stretchers listed above.

Product Description Two-stage and three-stage I.V. poles are shipped as an optional accessory to a bed or stretcher. The safe working load of the two-stage permanently attached I.V. pole is 40 lb. (3005-009-001 Rev E). To avoid damage to the three-stage I.V. pole, the weight of the I.V. bags should not exceed 12 lb. while the weight of any one item attached to each stage of the three-stage permanently attached I.V. pole should not exceed 9.3 lb. (Operations Manual 1105-109-001 Rev D).

> The I.V. poles are stationary, height adjustable stands intended to hold infusion liquids, infusion accessories, and/or other medical devices. They may be used on the following "parent" devices: Model 2030 (EPIC II), model 3005 S3 beds and stretcher models 1105, 1105E, 1105X, 1105XE, 1115, 1115E, 1115X, 1115XE, 1125E, 1125X and 1125XE.

Product Issue

It was identified by a customer complaint that some I.V. poles were retracting/lowering from an extended position to the low height unexpectedly. An investigation was initiated which identified that the I.V. Latch Housing was nonconforming.

Potential Hazard

We have identified the following potential hazards:

- Suspended I.V. pole retracts unexpectedly
- Suspended I.V. pole retracts unexpectedly with pump/bags attached

Our medical risk assessment has determined that the probability of harm requiring medical intervention associated with these hazards is negligible for patients and remote for individuals other than patients.

Actions Needed

- 1. Locate the bed(s) and/or stretcher(s) listed by serial number on the attached business reply form.
- 2. Place the I.V. pole(s) in the lowest position.
- 3. Hang the enclosed label in a visible manner on one of the hooks of the I.V. Pole.
- 4. A Stryker Representative will contact your facility to schedule a time for repair.
- 5. Return a copy of the enclosed business reply form to confirm receipt of this notification to the undersigned or to your local Stryker representative.
- 6. If you have further distributed the I.V. Poles listed in this letter, please forward a copy of this notice to the new users and advise us of their new location..
