Philips recently became aware that one lot of Lithium-ion Rechargeable Batteries for the Philips MX40 Wearable Monitor may have a manufacturing defect that may affect the operation of the monitor. This Field Safety Notice is intended to inform you about:

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION	One lot of Lithium-ion Rechargeable Batteries for the Philips MX40 Wearable Monitor may have a manufacturing defect that may affect the operation of the monitor. These batteries were under investigation for poor workmanship by the supplier and did not meet Philips quality criteria for sale.
HAZARD INVOLVED	Use of the affected battery could possibly result in a delay of patient treatment due to the loss of monitoring if the battery fails while the MX40 is in use.
HOW TO IDENTIFY AFFECTED PRODUCTS	(battery front) (battery back showing REF number) (top of battery showing lot number location)
	In order to identify an affected battery, the battery must first be removed from the MX40. The pictures above show the front, back and top of the battery. The model number (REF) is located on the back of the battery in the area outlined in red, and the lot number can be found on the top of the battery in the area outlined in green.



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ACTION TO BE TAKEN BY CUSTOMER / USER	Users should check all MX40s that may contain an affected battery, immediately remove any affected batteries found and replace them with unaffected batteries. Return the affected batteries using the address and RMA Number provided below. Also included with this communication is a return label for your use in returning affected batteries to Philips.
