

# Urgent Field Safety Notice 2016-01/01

#### **Description of the problem and established root causes:**

Due to a software programming error in the current version of EyeSuite i.8.2.1.0, patient data can be stored under the wrong patient on the DICOM Server.

Data mix up on the DICOM storage system only occurs, if the system is used in an unusual way, following a non-standard workflow, e.g. if the examiner returns unplanned to a patient on the worklist who is already completed and changes are made to the records. After the data has been saved, they will be stored on the DICOM Server under the last planned patient edited in the worklist.

The data on the EyeSuite database is not affected by this mix up and always displays the correct information




#### Measures to be taken by the user

➢ If you are using EyeSuite version i.8.2.1.0 in Connection with DICOM, please follow the instructions below:

Steps to avoid data mix up on DICOM Systems with i8.2.1.0:

- Only create data for actual Worklist entries.
- The order, how you select worklist entries does not matter.
- **Don't** add / change data to Patient files that you already completed the worklist entry.
- If you need to add / change data on a Patient, create a new worklist entry for the specific task.



➢ If you have not updated to the current version EyeSuite i.8.2.1.0, your system is not affected by this error. Do not update to version i.8.2.1.0. Older versions are not affected by this error.

#### **Further measures**

Haag-Streit currently is working on a new software version solving the issue and this will become available in the next weeks.

Once a corrected version of EyeSuite is available, your dealer will contact you for an update.
