



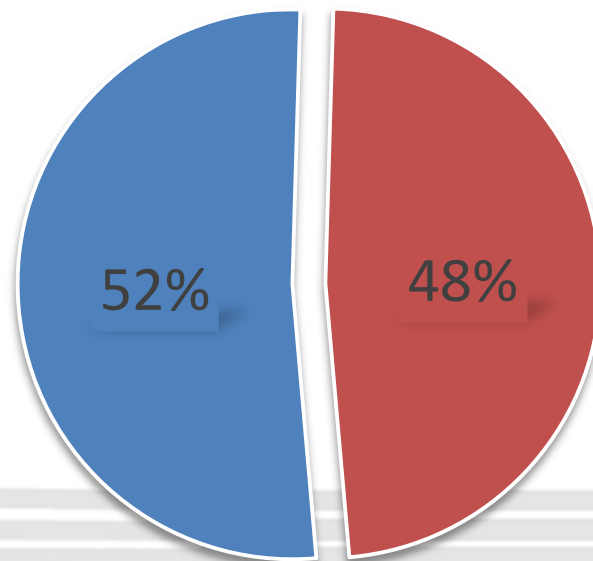
TRENDING OF GOOD DISTRIBUTION PRACTICE (GDP) DEFICIENCIES 2019

Summary of GDP Inspections in 2019

- 162 GDP inspections were conducted in 2019.
- 84 out of 162 inspections conducted (52 %) were found to have **no** deficiencies.
- 78 out of 162 inspections conducted (48 %) were found to have deficiencies.



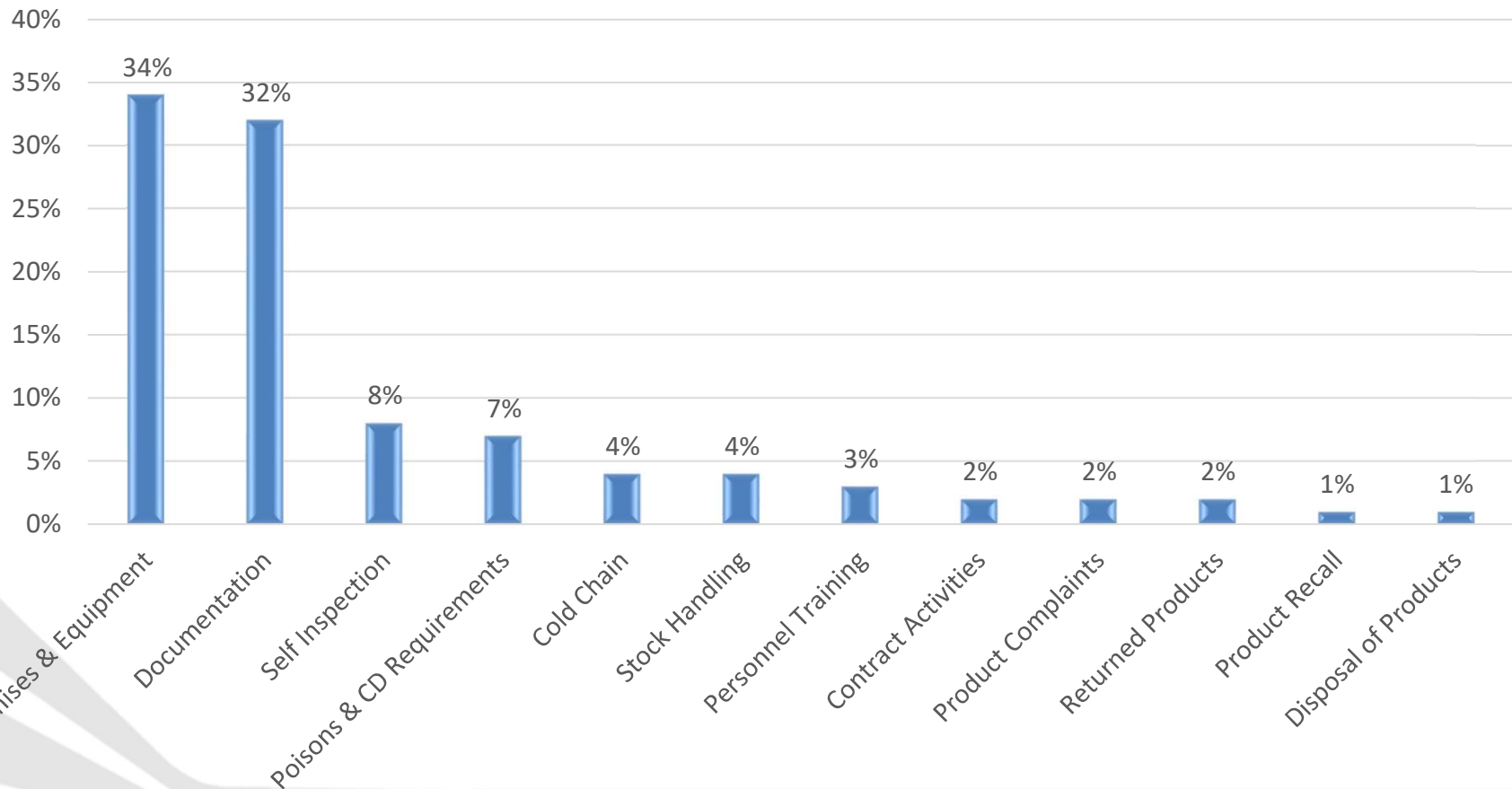
