



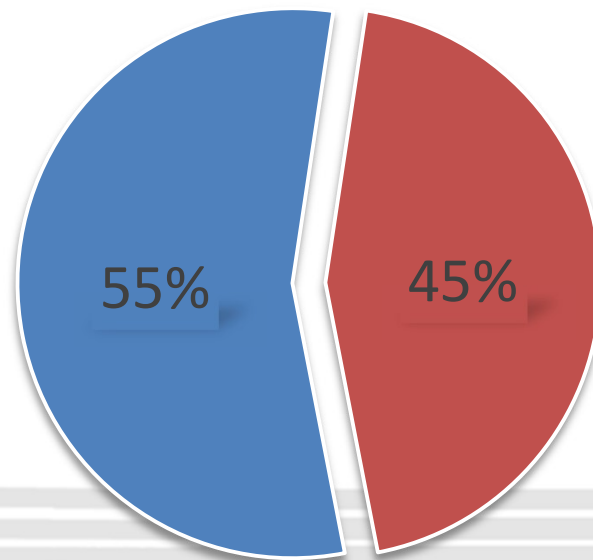
TRENDING OF GOOD DISTRIBUTION PRACTICE (GDP) DEFICIENCIES 2020

Summary of GDP Inspections in 2020

- 175 GDP inspections were conducted in 2020.
- 97 out of 175 inspections conducted (55 %) were found to have **no** deficiencies.
- 78 out of 175 inspections conducted (45 %) were found to have deficiencies.



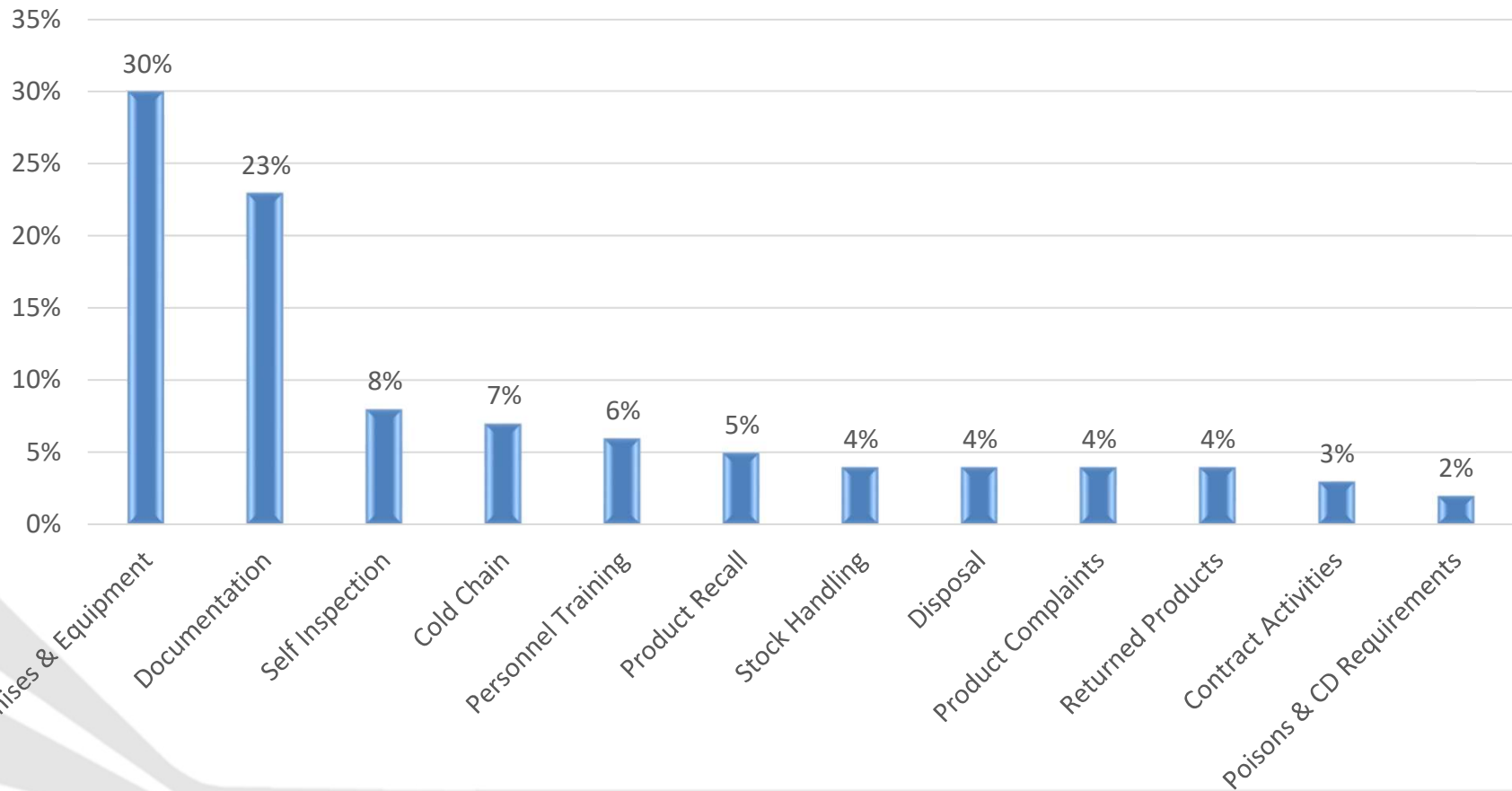
