


TRENDING OF GOOD DISTRIBUTION PRACTICE (GDP) DEFICIENCIES 2021

Summary of Routine GDP Inspections in 2021


- 135 Routine GDP inspections were conducted in 2021.
- 62 out of 135 inspections conducted (46 %) were found to have **no** deficiencies.
- 73 out of 135 inspections conducted (54 %) were found to have deficiencies.

Comparing Top 5 GDP Deficiencies Observed in 2020 & 2021

2021

#	GDP Chapters	Percentage
1	Premises & Equipment	35%
2	Documentation	19%
3	Cold Chain	8%
3	Self Inspection	8%
5	Returned Products	6%

Top two deficiencies remain unchanged, while deficiencies on Cold Chain and Self Inspections tie at 3rd place.
